## Module 1: INTRODUCTION: THE SPECIFICITIES OF SMEs

The first module provides SMEs' decision makers and consultants with a short introduction to the BALANCE project whose aim is to develop and provide SME decision makers and consultants with an innovative program to help them transform EMEs into greener operations, while improving their financial literacy and enhancing their environmental awareness. Towards that goal this introductory module provides a short overview of the existing approaches to SMEs and the need for a new approach (definition, role and greening), which in turn require, in approaching and evaluating them, the use of a set of attributes that are related to: the advantages they exhibit; the enterprising environment within which they operate; and the greening aspects they apply.
