HOLISTIC TRAINING PROGRAM

The survey to national SMEs previously conducted by the Balance project team revealed that SMEs decision-makers are doubtful about the economic return of green measures. In addition, they pointed out the gap of basic knowledge about green measures.

That is why we are currently developing a comprehensive **Training Program**, soon accessible on our project website (https://www.balanceproject.eu/).



WHAT IS NEXT?

All partners, under the supervision of Politeknika Txorierri and IDEC, are now working on the modules of the Training Program. The Training will then be divided in two variations: one targeted to **SMEs' decision-makers** and the other one targeted to **Business consultants** working with SMEs.
